SPIRIT AWARD – LIST OF COMPETITIVE EVENTS

It's the 2nd year of our new Homecoming Week tradition, the Homecoming Class Olympics! Classes will battle each other for the Homecoming Spirit Week Award! Classes will compete in the events listed below throughout the week to earn points. The winning class will earn a pizza and ice cream luncheon, and of course, bragging rights!

Daily Dress Up Day Participation

At the beginning of 1st hour, NHS members will come around to get a count of how many members of each class are dressed up for that day's dress up theme. Vo-Tech students that dress up will need to check in with Mrs. Hall when they get back to be counted for their class. If you are tardy and miss the count at the beginning of the hour, you won't be counted. At the end of the week, we will calculate the overall percentage of students per class that dressed up daily. The class with the highest overall percentage of class members participating will win this competition!

Loose Change Jar Challenge

Check those couch cushions and bring in any and all loose change! Each class will have a jar at the office where they can deposit their loose change. Change deposits will only be accepted from **7:45-8:00** before 1st hour every morning at the office. All proceeds from the Loose Change Jar Challenge will be donated to the Princeton VFW (Veterans of Foreign Wars) in honor of Staff Sergeant Ethan Sticken. Mr. Sticken is our high school science teacher and he is currently deployed serving our country. The class who donates the most loose change will win this category!

Homecoming Spirit Posters

Classes will decorate and submit up to 8 posters according to the Homecoming theme to hang in their designated wall in the hallway. Posters must be hung up by **8:00 a.m. Wednesday morning of Homecoming week** to be considered for judging in the competition. If your posters are late, they WILL NOT be judged. Class officers can pick up poster board from Mrs. Hall starting Monday, September 12th. Class officers should then give posters to those classmates that want to make a poster. Some will have to share as there are only 8 per class. Only members of your class may work on creating the posters. No parents, teachers or students/people outside of your class may create the posters. At the end of the week, posters can be taken down and used to cheer on the Tigers during the football game! Posters will be judged by a committee on the criteria listed in the following pages.

Outdoor Spirit Banner

Each class (7-12) will be given a twin size white sheet to design a Homecoming spirit banner. These banners will be hung on the front of the bleachers for Friday night's football game. Class officers can pick up sheets from Mrs. Hall starting Monday, September 12th. Banners must be delivered to Mrs. Hall by **2:00 p.m. on Thursday of Homecoming week** to be considered for judging in the contest. If your banner is late, it WILL NOT be judged. Please make sure your banners are dry, or at least mostly dry, when you deliver them. Only members of your class may work on creating the banner. No parents, teachers or students/people outside of your class may create the banner. Banners will be judged by a committee on the criteria listed in the following pages. The class that scores the highest will win this contest!

Homecoming Parade Float

Each class will construct a float for the annual Homecoming parade on Friday. Each class has received a \$50 donation to help purchase supplies. Floats must encompass the Homecoming theme and promote school spirit. Floats will be judged during the parade on the criteria listed in the following pages. The class that scores the highest will win this category!

Pep Assembly Participation

Classes will be judged on their overall participation and school spirit displayed during the pep assembly. Classes should sit together, participate in chants and games, and display positive school spirit and behavior throughout the duration of the assembly. The class that scores the highest will win this final event!

Scavenger Hunt

Classes will compete in a Scavenger Hunt throughout the week. These will be tasks that will be completed outside of school as they require the use of a cell phone and an app. The Scavenger Hunt is in an app called “Goosechase” and students will need to download the app on their phones to compete. Students can work in teams with some of their classmates. There can be as many people on the team as you wish, BUT only 5 cell phones can be used for a single team in the app. **Instructions on how to join the hunt are posted on your grade’s Google Classroom.** The Scavenger Hunt goes live **Saturday, September 17th at 8:00 a.m. and ends Friday, September 23rd at 8:00 a.m.** The highest scoring team from each grade will represent their class in the final standings to win this event.

Friday Funday Activities

There will be various competitive events between classes held on Homecoming Friday. These will be some of the final opportunities to win points for your class! More details about the events will be shared closer to Homecoming Week.
