The Princeton R-V Board of Education held two meetings on Monday, August 15, 2022. The following highlights of the board meeting are included:

Princeton Tax Rate Hearing

The board approved the proposed tax rate as presented to the Board of Education for the 2022-23 School Year. Incidental rate would be \$4.1113, Debt Service rate would be \$0.9532, and Capital Projects rate of .1800 for a total tax rate of \$5.2445 per \$100 assessed value.
