**Old Business**

- The School Board approved the annual Auditors Reports from the firm of Conrad & Higgins.
- The School Board tabled the review of board policies until the January meeting.

**New Business**

- The school board approved the renewal of liability & property insurance with CPSK & Missouri Public Entity Risk Management Fund (MOPERM) for a total of \$92,803. This is an increase of \$10,322 from the previous year.
- The School Board Approved a Resolution for Participation in MOCAAT & the Instrument of Adoption. The Missouri Capital Asset Advantage Treasury (MOCAAT) was established by Missouri public entities and associations seeking a full-service investment program to offer investments that maintain safety and liquidity while providing a competitive yield. The Program includes a full range of investment options and services, including online transactions and reporting. MOCAAT provides a vehicle for investment in U.S. government obligations, agencies, commercial paper and other high-quality short-term instruments allowable under MO State Statutes. The combined purchasing power of public entities contributes to attractive interest rates for MOCAAT Participants.
