Old Business

- Grant Updates: On June 30, 2023, Governor Mike Parson signed House Bill No. 2 for Fiscal Year 2024 (FY2024) which appropriated \$50 million in funding for a second round of School Safety Grants to support physical safety improvements in local school districts. In September, Princeton R-V was approved for \$50,000 to be utilized in new purchasing three new sets of doors at the High School building. In addition, the District will look to improve access control with the purchase of an electronic door access system that can be implemented campus wide. The district will be working with suppliers to evaluate implementation for the new doors and access controls.

New Business

- 2023 Board Policy & Regulation Updates were presented for review. These updates are slated for approval at the upcoming January meeting.
- The Board approved the District Reading Success Plan. The plan will address reading proficiency/readiness screening; a provision of intensive reading instruction particularly to students exhibiting a substantial reading deficiency and informing and involving parents/guardians in improvement of student reading proficiency/readiness.

The board went into closed session at 6:00pm.

The Board accepted the transfer of Extra Duty assignment for A+ Coordinator from High School Principal Dana Seymour to High School Counselor Heather Hall.

The Board approved the hire of Elizabeth Oliver as evening custodian for the Elementary building.
